



2019 College Summer Internship Program

The Pathways College Summer Internship Program is an excellent opportunity for College students to experience hands-on ministry training in an enjoyable, team-based, fast-paced, multicultural, and God-honoring church leadership development environment. This flexible 8-week program is designed for students who have a heart to serve in church-based ministries. The purpose is to equip students to grow personally and professionally in order to excel in their skills, knowledge, and passion in making disciples within the local church.

WHO: Requirements

- Completed a minimum of one semester of college (aged 18-25)
- Positions available for male and female interns in all departments
- Solid believer in Jesus Christ as personal Lord and Savior
- Interest in discerning future ministry possibilities
- 1-4 openings for:
 - Children's Ministry (K-5)
 - Student Ministry (grades 6-12)
 - Worship Ministry (instrumental, vocal, technical)
 - Discipleship Ministries (social media, curriculum, online training)

WHAT: Program description

- 8 weeks/20 weekly hours on avg/160 hours total
- Unpaid Internship w/ \$1000 tuition grant upon successful completion
- Skills training in assigned ministry area
- Vocational ministry experiences
- Self-guided development checklist
- 8 weeks of Leadership Development Training

WHEN:

- 8 weeks: early June through early August (starting and ending dates are flexible)
- Weekly time off and July 4 holiday

FORMS:

- Personal documents
 - Application
 - Daily log/journal entries of experiences
 - Final evaluation
- School Documents
 - If your school gives credit for internships, we are happy to provide appropriate documentation
- Pathways documents
 - One or two-page summary of your 8-week experience including excerpts from your journal entries at conclusion
 - Personality Profile (Myers-Briggs, Strength-Finders, or similar)
 - Spiritual Gifts inventory and interpretation
 - Supervisor Evaluation Form

HOURS:

- 100 hours serving in primary ministry
 - Help plan and execute weekly ministry environments
 - Learn email/phone etiquette
 - Learn social media appropriateness
 - Participate in ministry area weekly meetings
 - Contribute to service planning and preparation
- 20 hours learning other ministry areas/administration
 - Ministry platform, budget, philosophy
- 20 hours leadership development classes
 - Staff meetings, leadership development, spiritual disciplines development
 - Individualized consultation with 5 different ministry leaders during internship
- 20 hours overview of various church operations

Application process opens April 1 with an initial response deadline of April 30, though late applications may be accepted, and positions remain open until filled. Acceptances and notifications may begin as soon as May 1.
